ADES Child Care Assistance Program

The Division of Child Care offers childcare assistance for low-income working families and families in other challenging situations. You can find all necessary forms at the ADES website: des.az.gov/services/child-and-family/child-care/how-apply-for-child-care-assistance

Apply for ADES childcare assistance by submitting the following to a local office:

- A completed Application for Child Care Assistance
- Proof of identity for the applicant
- Proof of U.S. Citizenship or Qualified Immigrant Status for all children needing care
- Include our school's DES Provider #: P0028183301

Once your application is received:

- An Eligibility Specialist will contact you for an interview.
- The Eligibility Specialist will let you know if additional information is needed.
- Please do not disregard correspondence from the DES Division of Child Care, as this may delay services.

Quality First Scholarships

Quality First Scholarships are awarded **first-come-first-served** to eligible families based on family eligibility criteria formed by First Things First. Applications open in July. To receive a scholarship, families must complete an application, attach the required documentation, and provide it to Chandler Jewish Preschool. A scholarship may not cover all charges. Families are responsible for all necessary copayments.

MINIMUM REQUIRED COPAYMENT

Per child in care	Daily Rate—\$0.50	Daily Rate—\$1.00	Daily Rate—\$1.50	Daily Rate—\$2.50
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For families receiving Transitional Child Care (TCC) there is no copay assigned beyond the 3rd child in the family

Daily rate = 15 minutes or more

Families receiving Child Care Assistance based on the Department of Child Safety/Foster Care, the Jobs Program or those who are receiving Cash Assistance and are employed, may not have an assigned fee level or a minimum required copayment. However, all families may be responsible for charges above the minimum required copayments if a provider's rates exceed allowable state reimbursement maximums and/or the provider has other additional costs.

* Federal Poverty Level (FPL) = US DHHS 2022 poverty guidelines. The Arizona state statutory limit for child care assistance is 165% of the Federal Poverty Level.

** Federal Child Care & Development Fund (CCDF) statutory limit is 85% of the Federal Fiscal Year 2023 State median income (SMI).
